

## MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT Asim F. Belgaumi, MD Professor Department of Oncology Aga Khan University, Medical College Karachi, Pakistan

Welcome to our first POEM newsletter for 2021. In fact, welcome to 2021; especially since 2020 was such an unexpectedly difficult year for the whole world. The COVID-19 pandemic disrupted our personal and professional lives to an unprecedented level. We started with not knowing how to care for our patients, whether we should give them therapy or not. And when we wanted to give them the treatment they needed we weren't sure if the supplies of required medications would be available. But we adapted, and learned, and worked with our patients and families to patiently maneuver through the uncertainties towards rational approaches to childhood cancer treatment. Pediatric oncology care providers, forever striving to do more.

We also didn't get to meet each other, and that to me has been equally frustrating. Pediatric oncology is a small community, a family that loves to have reunions, share stories and experiences, and learn from each other. Conferences, workshops, and meetings, our usual "family reunions", were first postponed and then made virtual. "Virtual" is defined as something that is 'almost, but not quite' the real thing, and that is what these virtual encounters on computer terminals feel like. We couldn't hold our POEM Business meeting in Oman or travel to Canada for the SIOP congress.

But POEM remained active, and in some ways was more active than in previous years. We have certainly grown; our membership has increased by a whopping 49% and we now stand at 760 members. We started by relooking at the way we work and restructured our administrative configuration. A new composition and methodology for selection of the Board of Directors were implemented; we held our first elections according to this and chose an expanded Executive Committee, which has started working enthusiastically since October 2020.

The POEM group website has been revamped and boasts much better content and functionality. This is, obviously, a work in progress, and will continue to evolve and improve. We now have a 'Members Only' area, which permits better communication and collaboration opportunities. We are also working to enhance the educational content and hopefully will soon be able to post lecture videos and publications.

We are continuing with the Case Discussion fora and are starting the Nursing Journal club. Our first distance learning experience with workshops was a resounding success. The two POEM-St Jude workshops on Methodologies in Cancer Research and Registries and Nursing allowed us to reach out to more people and to utilize teaching methodologies that could not be used otherwise. This has led to the development of a new resource for our members; provision of mentorship for research and the formulation of a Research Advisory Committee.

POEM has also been more visible externally. We have published papers as a collaborative group, cosponsored conferences, and been invited to work with the WHO-EMR. We are receiving recognition as a significant regional and international player in the pediatric oncology arena.

I would like to express my sincere gratitude to Dr. Abdul Hakim Al-Rawas (Immediate Past President) and Dr. Samar Al-Muwakkit (Immediate Past Treasurer), and all the members of the Board of Directors who completed their term in October. It is their guidance and hard work that has led POEM to where it is at. Their support and advice continue to be needed as we move forward, expanding our scope and enriching the pediatric oncology experience in our region.



## A DIRECTED ON-SITE PEDIATRIC ONCOLOGY NURSING WORKSHOP

Yeolyan, conducted the pediatric oncology Training Program in Yerevan, Armenia on September 30 – October 5, 2019. the program aimed at developing the knowledge and skills of Registered Nurses in managing pediatric oncology patients in a pediatric oncology hospital in Yerevan- Armenia. It provided the participants with the needed knowledge and skills that guide the delivery of competency-based nursing care that is evidence-based for pediatric oncology patients.

#### WHO Global Initiative for Childhood Cancer



During the meeting, areas of GICC implementation efforts were discussed, including advocacy/awareness, clinical management, capacity development, access to care and medications, surveillance, and support.

# **9TH BOARD OF DIRECTORS BUSINESS MEETING**


